Cleaning: Remove old flowers, stems, and leaves. Once vegetables have stopped producing, remove the plants to reduce potential insect and disease problems. At the end of the season, cut back perennials, remove old annuals, and renew your beds with Black Gold® Natural & Organic Flower & Vegetable Soil.
