Black Gold® Natural & Organic Flower & Vegetable Soil

1 Bed Prep: Use Black Gold® Natural & Organic Flower & Vegetable Soil to renew in-ground gardens and raised beds. Cover weed-free beds with 2 to 3 inches of amendment, work it in using a hand spade or rototiller, then level the soil with a hard rake. For individual plantings, amend planting holes as needed. Use the chart below to determine the bales needed for coverage.



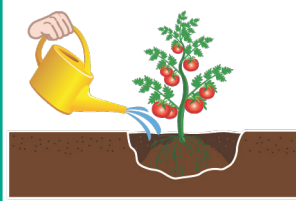
2 Planning: When planning your garden, choose plants with similar growing needs. To save time and effort, choose low-maintenance varieties. Plan beds for the right season: Cool-season plants can endure mild spring frosts, while warm-season plants must be planted after the threat of frost has passed.



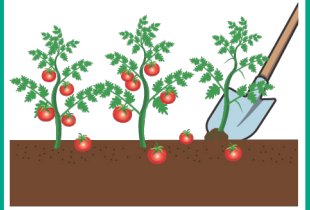
3 Planting: Dig a planting hole slightly wider and no deeper than the root ball. Gently loosen the roots of pot-bound plants for better soil-to-root contact. Work soil around the roots for full coverage and to remove air pockets. Brush excess mix off of any leaves and stems.



4 Watering & Feeding: New plantings need regular water and fertilizer for good growth and establishment. Water beds deeply to ensure full saturation. Start a supplemental feeding program one week after planting. Feed plants regularly with a fertilizer formulated for the plantings. Follow manufacturer's recommendations.



5 Cleaning: Remove old flowers, stems, and leaves. Once vegetables have stopped producing, remove the plants to reduce potential insect and disease problems. At the end of the season, cut back perennials, remove old annuals, and renew your beds with Black Gold® Natural & Organic Flower & Vegetable Soil.
